Access to Devonshire Care Centre:

Devonshire Care Centre offers a home to 132 residents requiring Continuing Care Services. The centre offers both private and semi private accommodations. Waitlist and admission policies are managed by Alberta Health Services.

Referrals to Devonshire Care Centre are made on behalf of resident and/or family by a Case Coordinator with either Homecare/Acute Care Hospital or Community Access.

Accommodation Fees:

Accommodation fees are periodically set by the Ministry of Seniors and Community Supports and are the same throughout the province. Additional charges are reviewed and adjusted annually.

Effective July 1, 2016, the accommodation charges for long-term care residents will increase by three percent. These charges are the monthly amount you pay for your accommodation-related services such as meals, housekeeping, utilities and routine building maintenance.

Alberta Health has approved a further three percent increase effective July 1, 2017. Beginning in 2018, the accommodation charge will increase annually based on the Consumer Price Index. This will allow fees to keep pace with inflation.

The following is a summary of accommodation and additional services cost currently in place.

Private Room	\$64.10 Per Day Approximately \$1,923.00 per month
Semi-Private Room	\$55.45 Per Day Approximately \$1,719.00 per month

Additional Services

Personal Laundry	\$50.00 per month
In Room Telephone	\$32.00 per month
Cable Television	\$25.00 per month
Clothing Labelling	\$40.00 on admission

When you move into Devonshire Care Centre, an Accommodation Agreement will be completed. The Accommodation Agreement outlines the rental agreement and services provided. The Care Centre is responsible to notify families and residents of any accommodation fees increase. The government has approved annual increases effective July 1 of each year.
